REFLECTION

“God will see justice done to his chosen who cry to him.”

In today’s Gospel, Jesus tells his disciples that if they ask for justice from God then they will receive justice from God. In many ways the judge acts for his good because he is sick of the widow pestering him, when god acts, he acts for our good and so sometime we think he acts the wrong way, but of course we are not aware of the bigger picture. God doesn’t believe in quick fixes rather he wants to help our long term welfare, he looks at our life as a whole and what will be good for us.

This Parable reminds me of a friend of mine who studied for the Priesthood, for many years he struggled with exams; he found academic work very hard. He would often stay late in the library. Just before he was ordained he was sent for a test and it was discovered that he had dyslexia. The test showed that he had difficulty processing information but that his in terms of intelligence he was in the top three percent in the country. The first thing he said to me was what I could have achieved if I had known this earlier. I said that if he had of known earlier we would never have met and his life would be totally different. He agreed and it cheered him up.

God does not always act the way we would like, but he does act for the good because he knows the bigger picture, not only of life here on earth but eternal life in heaven with him in glory. So let us never stop praying to god and asking him for help, because he is a judge who will act for our benefit and for our good.
