**REFLECTION**

*“Who is my neighbour?”*

In today’s Gospel we hear the familiar story of the Good Samaritan. It’s a story we know very well. The Samaritan is the one you would least expect to help, but he does. Time and again we are told that everyone in the world is our neighbour, but I wonder whether we can ever comprehend what that means.

I can always remember going to Pantomimes as a child and wondering why we cheered some characters and booed the others. What made someone good and someone else bad? Then when the performance had finished everyone got a cheer. In life Jesus knows that some people are good and some are bad, he knows that we make mistakes as well. To love our neighbour is to try and get on with them, but this will not always be possible. A relationship is a two way thing; someone always has to respond to us. What Jesus asks is that we treat each other with dignity, as a child of God.

Life is complicated, but if we are able to pray for each other, then just like when the Pantomime finishes, we will be giving a cheer in heaven to all of those who are our neighbours.
