REFLECTION

In today’s Gospel, Jesus tells Martha that her sister, Mary, has chosen the better part by sitting down and listening to him. Is Jesus saying that hospitality is not a good thing? Not all, he is simply questioning what we do with our time. He doesn’t say that Martha is in the wrong, he simply asks her to think about what she is doing. It’s the difference between, “doing” and “being”.

How often do we waste time by doing something that is not necessary rather than facing up to something that needs to be dealt with? It is very easy at times to turn a deaf ear to someone who is trying to help us, especially if we don’t like the advice.

In the Gospel Jesus is asking us to have a balance in our lives. Those who are drawn to the ministry of service and doing things, need to spend time in prayer and contemplation, and those who are drawn to contemplation, need to ground their prayer inaction, one feeds the other.

Both listening and praying and giving hospitality are correct, we just need to balance one with the other.
