## **REFLECTION**

*“Jesus resolutely took the road for Jerusalem. I will follow you wherever you go.”*

On Wednesday we celebrated the feast of St Thomas More and St John Fisher, two English martyrs whose faith was so strong that they were willing to give their lives for Jesus. In the Gospel today we are reminded of the mission each one of us is given, which is to follow Jesus.

Being a follower of Jesus and having faith in the Gospel is not always easy and can be a test, however, it can also be a rock for us to cling to. I can remember swimming in a Gala many years ago and winning the backstroke race, when I got out of the pool and went to shake hands with my friend who was second, who greeted me with “Next time I’ll have you!” I said “Not a Chance!” He replied “I’ve just been made head alter server so my faith is stronger than yours!” Then we had a shouting match, on the side of the pool.

Faith, is something that is very personal to us, but is also something we share. When we come to mass on a Sunday and partake in the Eucharist we enrich not only our faith, but the faith of everyone in the Church because we do it as a community. The English Martyrs died so that we might have the freedom to express our faith and mission “to follow me!” as a community before God.
