**REFLECTION**

Today we reach the Second Sunday of Advent and we are told of a voice crying in the wilderness which is John the Baptist.

Many years ago, I can remember passing the old Wembley Stadium and saw the bulldozers hovering outside, I began to get a bit nostalgic. I was reminded of when I was about 12 or 13 years old and went to see a football final there. It was the last time that 100,000 people were there. When we got to our place, my Father decided it would be better if I got higher up, because we were standing. So he lifted me up onto the roof. I grabbed hold of the iron girder holding the roof up and got one of the best views, even better than the royal box. The experience of seeing 100,000 people chanting, waiting for arrival of the two teams, was quite awe inspiring and with over half of them cheering for my team it was even better. When the teams arrived on the pitch the noise was deafening. When my team lost it wasn’t quite so good.

In our first reading from Isaiah the Isrealite people chant for God because they believe they have been abandoned. They chant for him to return. During advent we chant for Jesus to return again. We chant for the second coming of Jesus. Just like the football fans chanting for their team we chant for Jesus. We don’t know when he will come again all we know is, that unlike Wembey, God’s Kingdom will never be demolished. God is always there for us.

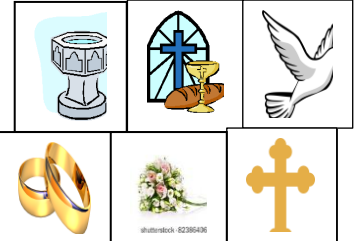
