## ***REFLECTION***

The third Sunday of Advent is called Gaudete Sunday. On this day the Priest wears a Rose/Pink colour vestment (if there is one available). This is to symbolise a half way point through the journey of Advent. In the early Church the purple vestment use to fade in colour and become more of a rose colour, so It would be retained and used on this Sunday to mark the half way point.

I can remember as a child going on holiday to the coast and especially the car we had at the time a (Cortina Estate ) which had been in the family for years. The car would always be laden down with luggage, bikes and food. It would usually make half way to the coast, before smoke would appear from the under the bonnet and we would have to pull into the side of the road. At this point my Father would mutter some strange Irish language as he was filling it with water. Then he would say “Right!” slam the bonnet down and in we all got for the last leg of the journey.

Today marks a change in our focus, we have been thinking about the second coming, now we begin this week to get ready to celebrate the first coming at Christmas. The readings have a slightly lighter feel as we have a mini celebration to remember the journey we have travelled and the journey we have yet to go.
