REFLECTION

In today’s Gospel, we hear Our Lord telling his followers about the destruction of the Temple in Jerusalem, an event which was to happen about the year AD70, when the Temple was indeed destroyed by the Romans. For many, this event marked the beginning of the end for creation. This was to be the first event which would eventually to the second coming of Christ. But this was not to happen, and indeed Our Lord tells us at the end of the Gospel “the end is not soon”.

In many ways, by predicting and waiting for this end of the world, we are missing two points. First we forget that God is not subject to time and will not act just because it is December 31st 1999 or any other date. He doesn’t have a calendar hanging up in heaven. God will act when he wants to act and not when we think he will, and we can’t influence this.

Secondly, we live in a world which is full of beauty, a world which was created for us by God to enjoy, a world which we have been entrusted to look after and take of. So let us enjoy this world because we won’t be here for ever. We can waste so much time living in the future or living in the past that we forget to enjoy the present.

On this remembrance Sunday, we remember all those who have lost their lives in all the Wars and as Christians we pray for them and those they have left behind and we must pray for peace. On this day let us learn from the past, work for peace in the present and help make a better future for everyone.
