REFLECTION

First Sunday of Advent

Today we celebrate a New Year of the Church and we asked to play a waiting game . It seems that at present in our society, some people are very bad at waiting patiently. I can think of nothing worse than waiting in a dentist or doctors waiting room, especially when I am on time and it is the doctor or dentist who is late. Or when I am waiting over an hour for a bus and then three come along all at once, or every time I approach a traffic light it appears to turn red as soon as I get to it. But in many of these scenarios, we know that there will be an end to the wait. The traffic will turn green eventually, the doctor and dentist will eventually get around to seeing us, and the bus will eventually come. Throughout Advent we are told that Christ,will one day come again and whilst we wait, a great Catholic and Jewish thing to do is chant.

In our first reading, Isaiah is chanting for the first coming of Jesus, and in the second reading Paul like us, is waiting for the second coming of Jesus. During Advent we Chant for Jesus to come again. We don’t know when he will come, so when he does let us be ready to welcome him.
