MESSAGE FROM FR. BRIAN – This weekend we celebrate Home Mission Sunday – the time annually when we are invited to pray for and support the church's work of Evangelisation in England and Wales. The theme this year is Evangelisation in the heart of the family. We are reminded that the work of evangelisation begins within our own families – in our homes – and also within the spiritual family of the Parish. Our Bishops ask that we reflect on how the Lord might be calling us to reach out to those we know who are non-churchgoing (lapsed) Catholics. There will be a retiring collection. Prayer Cards also available at the back of church.
