MESSAGE FROM FR. BRIAN – This weekend we celebrate the Feast of The Lateran Basilica. This feast marks the dedication of this church which is the cathedral of Rome (not St. Peters). The Lateran Basilica was built by Constantine and dedicated by Pope Sylvester in the Year 324. It is considered to be the Mother of all Latin Churches and the feast reminds us of our unity with Rome and the Pope.

This Sunday is Remembrance Sunday – a day we remember all the victims of war. At the beginning of the 10.30 am Mass there will be a period of silence to remember and honour all the fallen.
