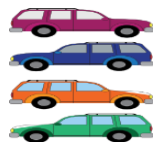

### REFLECTION –

Today's Gospel reminds me of an incident which happened when I was at school. There were two boys in my class who were always in trouble, occasionally I would get dragged into their plans for causing more trouble. However, on this occasion I was in the clear. The two of them had decided to run away, so at break time they decided to make break for it, they ran into the fields that backed on to our school. They remained on the run for a whole four hours until they both returned home because they were hungry and Grange Hill. was on the T.V. (whilst they could do without most things they couldn't do without Grange Hill). Much to their embarrassment this whole story was relayed to the rest of the class on the following day. We were also told that they weren't allowed to watch Grange Hill.

Today's Gospel talks about our relationship with God. It is a relationship based on love, trust and cooperation. God is our loving father who wants us to enjoy his creation and be able to take part fully in the world.

Like all relationships, however, there are times when it can become tense, there are times when we don't wish to listen to our Father, because we don't want to hear what he has to say to us. Or there are times when we think we know what is best. There can be times we want to run away and be apart from him. Although we may try to do this, it is impossible for us to live totally apart from God. Because he loves us so much he is watching over us the whole time, it is impossible for us to hide from him. He watches over us because he loves us so much and when we decide to ask forgiveness and return to the Father he is there waiting with open arms. Fr Anthony +
