**REFLECTION**

The gospel we have just listened to always makes me laugh, no sooner has Simon’s Mother in Law been cured then she is ask to wait on Sion, Andrew, James, John and Jesus, there doesn’t seem to be any time for convalescing or taking things easy. In the same way, Jesus doesn’t seem to want to take a rest. One would think that he might say, well let’s begin preaching here and then have a few weeks off and then consider going and preaching elsewhere, but we’ll see how it goes. He does not rest, his preaching is continuous.
