“Her many sins have been forgiven, or she would not have shown such love.”

In today's Gospel, we hear about a woman considered a sinner, who shows great love and compassion to Jesus. She anoints him with oil and in hindsight we know, that this is his anointing before he is to suffer the pain of the crucifixion.

Very often in life it can be the people who realise that they are imperfect, who show us the greatest example of how to care. The theologian Henri Nouwen wrote a book entitled “The wounded healer”. If we truly follow Jesus then we are all wounded healers.

A holy man walks past and throws a note saying, I'll say a prayer and walks past. Friends are important and very often, it is the true friends who help us out. Jesus is our true friend! Today let us pray for our friends and those who care for us.
