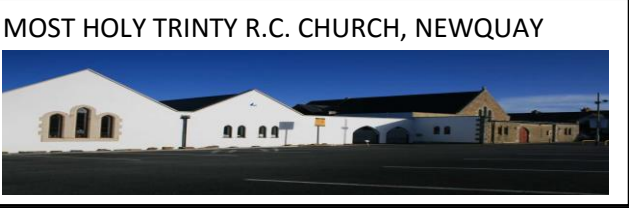

“They all ate as much as they wanted.”

In the Gospel today, we hear about the feeding of the five thousand. A miracle which is very familiar to us. It reminds us in a special way of the Eucharist, the body and blood of Jesus, which we receive when we come to Mass.
